

Welcome to the Door County Coastal Byway

You're invited to explore the Door County Coastal Byway!

This coloring book will be your guide along the byway's 66 miles of Wisconsin's beautiful Door Peninsula. Search for the Experience Kiosks in the communities as you travel, they will show and tell you about each area. Begin north of the City of Sturgeon Bay, follow either State Highway 57 or Highway 42 north, and Highway 42 to Northport to the very end of the Peninsula. Return south the opposite highway.

The route offers scenic views of Lake Michigan, the Bay of Green Bay and the Niagara Escarpment bluffs, of dense forest, farm lands, and quaint shore-side towns and villages. DCCB features three state parks, ten county parks and several lighthouses. Towns and villages along the way offer retail shops, galleries, live music and theatre, cherry and apple orchards, boating, fishing, hiking, golfing and many other fun activities.

Color the pictures in this book as you travel, and find the answers to the Scavenger Hunt questions on each of the Experience Kiosks along the route.

Enjoy the beaches and the rocky shores of the Bay of Green Bay and Lake Michigan. Learn about the history of the great communities. See the rugged bluffs of the Niagara Escarpment. Pick some cherries or apples. Enjoy many fun experiences suggested by our business friends along the way.













At a farm, pet the cows, feed the chicks, milk a goat.








Turn on County Rd WD to visit Whitefish Dunes State Park and Cave Point County Park. They are neighbors!









German Settlement






ELLISON BAY





Gills Rock was originally called "Hedgehog Harbor," named after a family of hedgehogs that took up residence in a local fisherman and boat-builder's sloop during the winter of 1855. Commercial fishing is still active in Gills Rock.

The furthest north Experience Kiosk is located in Porte des Morts Park. The park overlooks "Porte des Morts" or "Deaths Door", named for the many native warriors and sailors who have vanished in its turbulent waters. Catch the ferry to Washington Island from Northport.







Many great miniature golf courses as well as championship golf courses are found in Door County.




Harbor View Park, on the lakeside of town, holds the Experience Kiosk here. The village marina, beach and the park are all great stops to catch your breath.

Chief Oshkosh Trading Post is south of the Village of Egg Harbor. It was built over an Indian campsite. Chief Roy Oshkosh, Chief of the Menominee Indians in 1932, was well known throughout the state for his pageants, his work with Boy Scouts, and as an honorary member of the Order of the Arrow.

He was the first Indian in the U.S. to receive the honor.
